A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A STATE DISASTER PROJECT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF KETCHUM AND THE IDAHO BUREAU OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT TO THE CITY OF KETCHUM FOR THE SPRING 2006 FLOOD RESPONSE ACTIVITIES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$45,065.15.

WHEREAS, in the Spring of 2006, the City of Ketchum experienced high water levels, which lead to flooding in various areas throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, due to the flooding, several City departments were required to purchase equipment and supplies, as well as compensate employees for additional flood response activity work completed; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code §50-301, Ketchum is empowered to enter into contracts as may be deemed necessary to promote the public health, safety, and welfare of Ketchum and its residents; and

WHEREAS, both Ketchum and the Idaho Bureau of Homeland Security desire to enter into an agreement for reimbursement of equipment, services, supplies and labor associated with the 2006 Idaho Spring Flooding that took place within the City of Ketchum.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the Ketchum City Council that the Mayor is authorized to execute a State Disaster Project Agreement between the City of Ketchum and the Idaho Department of Homeland Security for the reimbursement to the City of Ketchum for the Spring 2006 Flood Response Activities in the amount of \$45,065.15.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this fourth (16th) day of July,

2007.
