

RESOLUTION NUMBER 07-105

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, PROVIDING FOR EXECUTION OF A RIGHT-OF-WAY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF KETCHUM AND WOOD RIVER COMMUNITY WI-FI CORPORATION CONCERNING THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF WIRELESS COMMUNICATION FACILITIES ON STREET LIGHTS ALONG MAIN STREET, SUN VALLEY ROAD, WASHINGTON AVENUE AND SECOND AVENUE IN THE COMMUNITY CORE ZONING DISTRICT, CITY OF KETCHUM.

WHEREAS, Wood River Community Wi-Fi Corporation wishes to install and maintain wireless communication facilities on street lights within the right of way along Main Street, Sun Valley Road, Washington Avenue, and Second Avenue in the Community Core Zoning District, as shown on Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum ("City") finds that said improvements will not impede the use of said right-of-way or jeopardize the public health, safety and welfare at this time subject to the terms and provisions of the Right-of-Way Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Wood River Community Wi-Fi Corporation desires to enter into the Right-of-Way Agreement with the City for the installation and maintenance of wireless communication facilities on street lights within the right-of-way along Main Street, Sun Valley Road, Washington Avenue, and Second Avenue in the Community Core Zoning District.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Ketchum:

1. The Right-of-Way Agreement for the installation and maintenance of wireless communication facilities on street lights within the right-of-way along Main Street, Sun Valley Road, Washington Avenue, and Second Avenue in the Community Core Zoning District, Ketchum, Idaho is hereby approved.

2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Right-of-Way Agreement on behalf of the City of Ketchum, Idaho.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this twentieth (20th) day of August, 2007.


