

RESOLUTION NUMBER 07-109

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO,
AFFIRMING MAYOR HALL'S PROCLAMATION DECLARING A LOCAL
DISASTER EMERGENCY AND EXTENDING SUCH DECLARATION FOR A
PERIOD OF THIRTY DAYS.

WHEREAS, by Proclamation dated August 20, 2007, Mayor Randy Hall declared a local disaster emergency pursuant to Idaho Code Section 46-1011 based on a wildfire currently burning on public and private lands within Blaine County in close proximity to the City of Ketchum presenting an imminent threat to the health, safety and welfare of all people in the City of Ketchum in addition to all private property, public property, infrastructure and utilities in the City of Ketchum and to the local economy; and

WHEREAS, such fire has been burning on public and private lands within Blaine County since Friday, August 17, 2007, and continues to burn; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code Section 46-1011 states that such declaration shall not be continued or renewed for a period in excess of seven days except by or with the consent of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the Ketchum City Council that Mayor Hall's Proclamation declaring a local disaster emergency is hereby affirmed and extended for a period of thirty (30) days.


This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this twentieth (20th) day of August 2007.



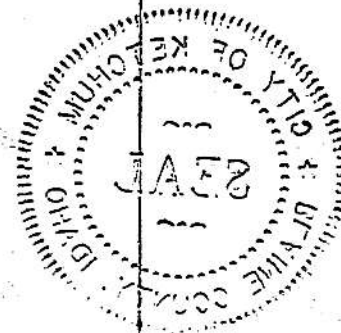

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, a wildfire is currently burning on public and private lands within Blaine County in close proximity to the City of Ketchum presenting an imminent threat to the health, safety and welfare of all people in the City of Ketchum in addition to all private property, public property, infrastructure and utilities in the City of Ketchum and to the local economy, and

WHEREAS, such wildfire constitutes a disaster emergency as defined in Idaho Code Section 46-1002; and


WHEREAS, such disaster emergency is likely to be beyond the control of the City of Ketchum's emergency response capabilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RANDY HALL, Mayor of the City of Ketchum, pursuant to Idaho Code Section 46-1011 do hereby find, proclaim and declare as follows:


1. That a state of local disaster emergency as described in Idaho Code Section 46-1001 *et seq.* exists in all areas located within the municipal boundaries of the City of Ketchum due to the imminent threat to the health, safety and welfare of all people in the City of Ketchum, private property, public property, infrastructure, utilities, the local economy due to wildfire.
2. That this declaration shall activate the response and recovery aspects of any and all applicable local or intergovernmental disaster emergency plans and to authorize the furnishing of aid and assistance there under.
3. That this declaration of local disaster emergency shall take effect immediately and continue for a period of seven (7) days, unless continued or renewed by the Ketchum City Council.


