

RESOLUTION NUMBER 07-112

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO,
AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A COST SHARE
AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES FOREST SERVICE IN RELATION TO THE
CASTLE ROCK FIRE.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code §50-301, Ketchum is empowered to enter into contracts as may be deemed necessary to promote the public health, safety, and welfare of Ketchum and its residents; and

WHEREAS, by Proclamation dated August 20, 2007, the Mayor declared a state of local disaster emergency as described in Idaho Code Section 46-1001 *et seq.* exists in all areas located within the municipal boundaries of the City of Ketchum due to the imminent threat to the health, safety and welfare of all people in the City of Ketchum, private property, public property, infrastructure, utilities, the local economy due to wildfire; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 07-109, passed on August 20, 2007, the City Council extended the declaration of a state of local disaster emergency for a period of thirty (30) days; and


WHEREAS, USFS Incident Commander, Jeanne Pincha-Tulley, has requested that a single, local entity enter a Cost Share Agreement with the USFS in order to make accounting and billing of costs related to the Castle Rock Fire as efficient as possible; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Pincha-Tulley has further requested that the City of Ketchum serve as that entity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the Ketchum City Council that the Mayor is hereby authorized and instructed to execute a Cost Share Agreement with the United States Forest Service in relation to the Castle Rock Fire.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this thirtieth (30th) day of August, 2007.
