

RESOLUTION NUMBER 07-120

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT WITH
THE CITY OF SUN VALLEY, CITY OF HAILEY, CITY OF BELLEVUE, CITY OF CAREY
AND BLAINE COUNTY TO PROVIDE MULTIMODAL PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION
SERVICES IN BLAINE COUNTY THROUGH THE MOUNTAIN RIDES
TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code Section 67-2328, state or public agencies may enter into agreements with one another for joint or cooperative action; and

WHEREAS, it is the mutual desire of the Parties hereto to maintain an Authority Board to procure, establish, operate, maintain and plan for a multimodal public transportation system in and between the corporate limits of Sun Valley, Ketchum, Hailey, Bellevue, and Carey and within Blaine County and outside of Blaine County to counties with commuters traveling to Blaine County and that there are no disruptions to public transportation services as the mutual terms, covenant and conditions of the Joint Powers Agreement are implemented; and


WHEREAS, Ketchum approved the Fiscal Year 2007-08 Budget, which included the amount of \$580,000 for the purpose of funding public transportation; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare to enter into an agreement with the City of Sun Valley, City of Hailey, City of Bellevue, City of Carey and Blaine County to provide multimodal public transportation services in Blaine County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Ketchum, Idaho that the City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute a Joint Powers Agreement with the City of Sun Valley, City of Hailey, City of Bellevue, City of Carey and Blaine County to provide multimodal public transportation services in Blaine County through the Mountain Rides Transportation Authority.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this first (1st) day of October 2007.
