

RESOLUTION 07-144

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM CITY COUNCIL TRANSFERRING
\$75,000 FROM GENERAL FUND CONTINGENCY TO CONTRACT FOR
SERVICES WITH BLAINE COUNTY FOR CONSOLIDATED DISPATCH

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum and Blaine County remain committed to implementing Consolidated Dispatch and that the physical consolidation of these operations is planned for December 15, 2007, and

WHEREAS, the FY 2007-2008 City Budget includes \$85,000 in the Contract for Services account as well as \$239,996 in the Communication Center account to enable this consolidation, and

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum will pay the operations of the Ketchum Communications Center through December 15, 2007, and remit to Blaine County the remaining balance in the Communication Center budget (01-4220), and


WHEREAS, the initial Contract for Services budget of \$85,000 needs an additional \$75,000 to fully fund all necessary consolidation expenses and that this additional \$75,000 is available by transfer from General Fund Contingency, and

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum will remit to Blaine County an additional \$160,000 from the Contract For Services account (01-4196-6090),

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Ketchum, Idaho, approves transfer of \$75,000 from General Fund Contingency (01-4193-9930) to Contract for Services (01-4196-6090) with Blaine County for Consolidated Dispatch

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this third (3rd) day of December 2007.
