

RESOLUTION NUMBER 07-154

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM CITY COUNCIL APPOINTING JIM JAQUET TO THE INTERIM CITY ADMINISTRATOR POSITION, EFFECTIVE UPON RON LE BLANC'S PHYSICAL DEPARTURE FROM THE OFFICE AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER A CONTRACT FOR SERVICES WITH JIM JAQUET TO PERFORM SUCH SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the current City Administrator, Ron LeBlanc, has delivered a letter of resignation to the City effective in early January, 2008; however, he has indicated that he might begin using accumulated executive time and/or vacation time prior to that and physically leave the office earlier without the intent to return; and

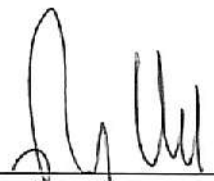
WHEREAS, it has been determined that an interim City Administrator is needed to carry out the duties of the City Administrator while the Mayor and City Council look for a new full-time City Administrator; and

WHEREAS, former City Administrator, Jim Jaquet, has agreed to fill the position of interim City Administrator; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Hall recommends Jim Jaquet be appointed by the City Council to serve as the interim City Administrator and that the City enter a contract for services with Mr. Jaquet to perform such services; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Ketchum, that Jim Jaquet is appointed as the interim City Administrator effective upon Ron LeBlanc's physical departure from the office and the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter a contract for services with Jim Jaquet to perform such services.

This Resolution with be in full force and effect upon its adoption this twelfth (12th) day of December, 2007.



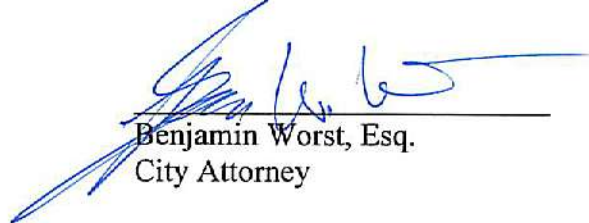
