

RESOLUTION NUMBER 08-005

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR SERVICES WITH THE GREG PROTHMAN COMPANY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$18,000, PLUS EXPENSES, FOR EXECUTIVE SEARCH SERVICES TO RECRUIT FOR THE POSITION OF CITY ADMINISTRATOR.

WHEREAS, the City has now concluded a request for proposals (RFP) process to locate an executive search firm to assist the City in hiring a new City Administrator in keeping with the Council Goal of "Best Practices" and according to the City Council policy on Requests for Proposals for professional services, and


WHEREAS, the City received nine (9) highly-qualified responses to the RFP which were presented to the City Council on December 3, 2007, and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the Greg Prothman Company's response to such RFP best suits the City's need for an executive search firm.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Ketchum, Idaho, that the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract for services with The Greg Prothman Company in an amount not to exceed \$18,000, plus expenses, to perform executive search services to recruit for the position of City Administrator.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this third (10th) day of December 2007.


