

RESOLUTION 08-013

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR SERVICES WITH THE WOOD RIVER IDAHO PARENT-TEACHER-STUDENT ASSOCIATION (IPTSA), IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000 TO PROVIDE A SUBSTANCE-FREE GRADUATION PARTY FOR THE CLASS OF 2008.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code Section 50-301, Ketchum has the authority to enter into contracts with outside agencies to provide services which are reasonably necessary to maintain the peace and promote the public health, safety and welfare of Ketchum's residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Ketchum City Council adopted Resolution 03-068, establishing policies and procedures regarding outside agency requests to enter such contracts to provide such services; and


WHEREAS, the Wood River IPTSA is such an outside agency, has satisfied the requirements of such policies and procedures and has offered to contract with Ketchum to provide a substance-free graduation party for the Class of 2008 in exchange for \$1,000 to pay for part of the cost of such party; and

WHEREAS, Ketchum approved the Fiscal Year 2007-08 Budget, which included the amount of \$1,000 for the purpose of funding such contract with the Wood River IPTSA; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare to contract with the Wood River IPTSA to provide a substance-free graduation party for the class of 2008.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ketchum City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to sign a contract for services with the Wood River IPTSA in the amount of \$1,000 to provide a substance-free graduation party for the Class of 2008.



This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this 19th day of February, 2008.



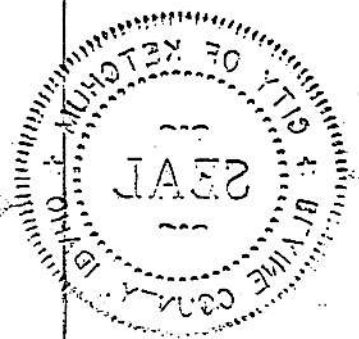
