

RESOLUTION NO. 08-033

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR SERVICES WITH THE KETCHUM COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$105,000 FOR CONSULTING SERVICES TO ASSIST THE CITY WITH AN AFFORDABLE WORKFORCE HOUSING DEMONSTRATION PROJECT, THE DESIGN OF PHASE II OF THE FOURTH STREET HERITAGE CORRIDOR AND SITE SELECTION FOR A REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION HUB.

WHEREAS, Ketchum is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Idaho; and

WHEREAS, the Ketchum Community Development Corporation is an Idaho nonprofit corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Idaho; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code §50-301, the City is empowered to enter into contracts as may be deemed necessary to promote the welfare of the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the KCDC has offered to provide consulting to assist the City with an affordable workforce housing demonstration project, the design of Phase II of the Fourth Street Heritage Corridor and site selection for a regional transportation hub; and

WHEREAS, Ketchum finds that such services will promote the general health, safety and welfare.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ketchum City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute a contract for services with the Ketchum Community Development Corporation in the amount of \$105,000 for consulting services to assist the City with an affordable workforce housing demonstration project, the design of Phase II of the Fourth Street Heritage Corridor and site selection for a regional transportation hub.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this nineteenth (19th) day of February, 2008.


