

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 08-034**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR SERVICES WITH THE BLAINE COUNTY HOUSING AUTHORITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$70,000 TO PROVIDE COMMUNITY HOUSING ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code Sections 50-301, Ketchum has the authority to enter into contracts to provide services which are reasonably necessary to maintain the peace and promote the public health, safety and welfare of Ketchum's residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, Blaine County Housing Authority has offered to provide community housing administrative services, which include assisting public entities and private developers with affordable housing product development, acting as the clearing house for the delivery of affordable housing product, generating and maintaining Community Housing Guidelines and monitoring compliance; and

WHEREAS, Ketchum desires to obtain such services necessary to create and manage community housing; and

WHEREAS, the Blaine-Ketchum Housing Authority has offered to provide such services in exchange for \$70,000; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare to contract with the Blaine County Housing Authority to provide Ketchum with community housing administrative services.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Ketchum, Idaho that the City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute a Contract for Services with the Blaine County Housing Authority in the amount of \$70,000 to provide community housing administrative services.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this nineteenth (19th) day of February, 2008.



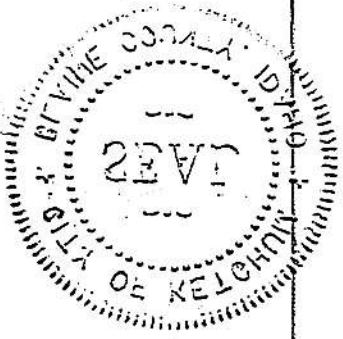
