A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO
ACCEPTING A BID FROM BURKS EXCAVATION, LLC FOR THE FOURTH
STREET HERITAGE CORRIDOR PHASE II IN THE AMOUNT OF \$577,148.00 AND
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO AWARD THE BID

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Downtown Master Plan that was approved by the City Council with Resolution No. 06-097 on September 8, 2006, a set of initiatives which includes physical improvements such as a Fourth Street Heritage Corridor should be implemented; and

WHEREAS, this the Fourth Street Heritage Corridor Phase II project was bid in compliance with Idaho Code § 67-2309; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum received 3 (three) bids from local companies that are familiar with designing and constructing a pedestrian-priority street; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that Burks Excavation, LLC has such skills and expertise to complete the project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ketchum City Council accepts a bid for the Fourth Street Heritage Corridor Phase II from Burks Excavation, LLC in the amount of \$577,148.00 and that the Mayor is hereby authorized to award the bid.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this seventh (23rd) day of April, 2008.


