

RESOLUTION NUMBER 08-058

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO THE BLAINE COUNTY AMBULANCE DISTRICT IN EXCHANGE FOR \$813,000.

WHEREAS, Blaine County, Idaho, established an ambulance service district pursuant to I.C. § 31-3901 *et seq.* and subsequently divided the Blaine County into two service sub-districts, and

WHEREAS, the duly created Blaine County Ambulance District desires that the City of Ketchum provide emergency medical services in the northern sub-district; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of these services, the Blaine County Ambulance District will pay the City of Ketchum EIGHT HUNDRED THIRTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$813,000); and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that providing such services and receiving the payment therefore will promote the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Ketchum because such residents often travel in the northern sub-district and because the increased volume of services will facilitate the expansion of the quality and complexity of the equipment and services provided by the City within the City and the sub-district.



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Ketchum, Idaho, that the City Council hereby authorizes and directs the mayor to execute an emergency medical services agreement to provide services to the Blaine County Ambulance District in exchange for \$813,000.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this twenty-first (21st) day of April 2008.


