

RESOLUTION NUMBER 08-062

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO,
AFFIRMING MAYOR HALL'S PROCLAMATION DECLARING A LOCAL
DISASTER EMERGENCY AND EXTENDING SUCH DECLARATION FOR A
PERIOD OF THIRTY DAYS.**

WHEREAS, by Proclamation dated May 19, 2008, Mayor Randy Hall declared a local disaster emergency pursuant to Idaho Code Section 46-1011 based on the imminent threat of flooding due to heavy spring runoff; and


WHEREAS, such disaster has not yet occurred and the date of such occurrence is uncertain but likely to be within the next several weeks; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code Section 46-1011 states that such declaration shall not be continued or renewed for a period in excess of seven days except by or with the consent of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the Ketchum City Council that Mayor Hall's Proclamation declaring a local disaster emergency is hereby affirmed and extended for a period of thirty (30) days.


This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this 19th day of May 2008.


