A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO AUTHORIZING AND INSTRUCTING THE MAYOR TO SELL KETCHUM POLICE K-9, SHADOW, TO HAILEY POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00).

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Ketchum Police Department that a Police K-9 has not been as effective in detouring drug usage in the Ketchum area and it has been decided that the City of Hailey has a significantly higher need, which will better suit the use of a Police Canine; and

WHEREAS, Hailey Police Department has expressed an interest in acquiring Shadow from the Ketchum Police Department with the agreement that the Canine, Shadow, can be used to assist the Ketchum Police Department in drug searches when requested; and

WHEREAS, Police Chief, Cory Lyman, recommends that the City sell Shadow to Hailey Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Ketchum, Idaho, that the City Council hereby authorizes and instructs the Mayor to sell Ketchum Police K-9, Shadow, to Hailey Police Department in the amount of one dollar (\$1.00).
