

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 09-027**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, APPROVING A CONTRACT FOR POLICE SERVICES WITH THE BLAINE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum is responsible for the provision of police services for certain crimes within the City limits; and


WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum has provided such police services by directly employing its own police officers; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that obtaining police services through the Blaine County Sheriff's Department will provide better training opportunities for officers, increased police presence in the City, increased police reserves in emergency situations, a significant cost savings to the City, and would be a benefit to the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Ketchum;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the Ketchum City Council that the Ketchum City Council, by motion at the City Council Meeting of June 15, 2009, approved a contract , effective July 1, 2009, between the City of Ketchum and the Blaine County Sheriff's Department for the provision of police services to the City of Ketchum for a term of fifteen months.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption and approval this sixth (6<sup>th</sup>) day of July, 2009.
