

RESOLUTION NUMBER 11-006

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, SUPPORTING THE PROJECT IDENTIFICATION SUBMITTAL FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF WARM SPRINGS ROAD/LEWIS STREET AND FLOWERS DRIVE ROUNDABOUTS AND SIDEWALK EXTENSIONS TO THE LOCAL HIGHWAY TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE COUNCIL (LHTAC); AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE PROJECT IDENTIFICATION SUBMITTAL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum is applying for a Local Highway Technical Assistance Council (LHTAC) Federal-aid Incentive Program—STP Rural Grant for the Warm Springs Road/Lewis Street and Flowers Drive Roundabouts and Sidewalk Extensions Project; and,

WHEREAS, the total project cost estimate is \$1,784,000, which will require \$130,946 of local matching funds available from the City of Ketchum; and


WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council deem it to be in the public interest of the City to apply for such grant.

This resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption as indicated hereinbelow.




