

RESOLUTION NUMBER 11-019

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, EXPRESSING THE DESIRE OF THE KETCHUM CITY COUNCIL TO HOLD A SPECIAL ELECTION TO CONSIDER THE ADOPTION OF THE COUNCIL-MANAGER PLAN OF GOVERNMENT; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO REVIEW THE PROCEDURES FOR ADOPTING THE COUNCIL-MANAGER PLAN, INCLUDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SPECIAL ELECTION DATE FOR ADOPTION OF SUCH PLAN; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ketchum desires to hold a special election to consider the adoption of the council-manager plan of government proceedings as set forth in Idaho Code §§50-801 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, prior to instituting the proceedings to establish such council-manager plan of government, the City Council desires to review the procedures set forth in Idaho Code §§50-801 *et seq.*, with the intention of holding a special election on the adoption of the council-manager plan.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the Ketchum City Council that the City Attorney is hereby authorized and directed to review the procedures for adopting the council-manager plan of government, including establishment of a special election for such purpose, potentially to occur on the May 2012 statutory election date, and to report back to the City Council on or before December 31, 2011.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption and approval this 18th day of July, 2011.
