

**RESOLUTION 14-011**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO  
ESTABLISHING A REBATE PROGRAM FOR CUSTOMERS CONVERTING OFF THE  
KETCHUM SPRINGS WATER SYSTEM TO THE KETCHUM CITY WATER SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, the Ketchum Springs Water distribution system is an old water system acquired by the City in the 1980's; and

WHEREAS, the Ketchum Springs Water distribution system was not appropriately constructed in various locations and therefore prone to water main breaks and operational dysfunctions; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum finds it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to discontinue the use of the Ketchum Springs Water distribution system within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum has been offering a rebate to encourage water customers who are served off the Ketchum Springs Water distribution system to connect into the newer Ketchum City Water main; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum finds that providing a rebate to convert to the City Water system is in the best interest of the City and its residents in order to eventually discontinue the Ketchum Springs Water distribution system in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

CONVERSION REBATE PROGRAM. Existing water customers are offered up to a \$1,000 (one thousand dollars) rebate from the City towards the new conversion of a private water service line or private fire service line from the Ketchum Springs Water system to the Ketchum City Water system. New water services shall meet the requirements of Ketchum City Code Chapter 13.08. The property owner is responsible for all construction costs associated with the conversion. If applicable, the City will provide a water meter and water meter horn or vault for installation by the property owner's contractor. To apply for the rebate property owners must notify the Ketchum Water Department prior to construction. No rebates will be paid for conversions done without prior approval from the Water Department. Payment will be made after construction has been completed and inspected by City personnel.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this 21<sup>st</sup> (twenty-first) day of April, 2014.
