JOB SUMMARY

Responsible for timely repair and maintenance of all equipment. Responsible for all shop activities, parts, maintenance records and work scheduling. Works safely under the supervision of the Supervisor or department Director. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Essential

- Responsible for ordering all shop consumable products and equipment parts
- Responsible for the record keeping of all shop activities and equipment maintenance
